#### Dog Waste

Unfortunately, we have received complaints from residents that dog owners are not picking up after their dogs.

It does not take much to remember that we have dogs in our community, in fact if you don't watch your step, you're liable to step in one such reminder! This applies to the pavements and to the playing field. Apart from being smelly and unsightly, dog waste is hazardous to the health of our children and other pets. A reminder that if you cannot see a dog waste bin, a tied-up bag can be put in any litter bin, alternatively take the bag home, do not leave on the side of the road for someone else to pick up.

Most dog owners in Freiston are responsible and pick up after their four-legged friends, but sadly there remains a very small minority who do not care about their surroundings.

Failure to pick up after your dog, or to carry poo bags can result in a fixed penalty notice of up to £100.

Let's ensure our pavements and playing field stay clean for everyone.
