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8.7: Lincolnshire County Council Bus Shelter Grant – Update

To consider whether the Parish Council wishes to proceed with the grant application for a new two-bay bus shelter at Church Road. Estimated cost is £6,000+, and two quotations will be required from different suppliers. Only one grant application can be submitted at a time; the Jolly Farmers shelter would follow with the same costings and requirements, after the Parish Council has considered whether to go ahead.

The application also requires a location plan, photographs, and a sketch of the proposed site. The Parish Council would be responsible for insurance and ongoing maintenance.
